Application Guide

New Concrete Surface

Sand down the plaster with Emery Stone and apply one coat of Rainbow Perfecton Wall Primer Sealer. Prepare the surface by applying 2 coats of Putty prepared with Perfecton Wall Primer Sealer, apply 2-3 coats of Rainbow Plastic Emulsion Paint.

Old Painted Surface

Remove all dust, Dirt and loose adherng or flaked paints by scraping, apply one Coat of Rianbow Wall Primer Sealer with slight over thinning this will help Sealer to penetrate into the surface apply second coat of sealer followed by filling after the surface is properly prepared apply 2-3 coats of Rainbow Plastic Emulsion Paint.
